Kids @ Iron Works

Jesus said, "Let the little children come to me." We believe that children are incredibly important, so we offer a nursery and more to help you worship. All our workers are trained and screened to ensure the safety of your child.

Restrooms are located in the hallway next to the sanctuary.

Nursery (for newborns to 3 yr olds) - includes special care, story time, and music. The nursery is located on the second floor.

Kids Church - is offered for 4 year olds - 2nd graders. The lesson corresponds with the weekly sermon. Children are checked-in during the break and dismissed before the sermon with a blessing.

Doodle Clipboards - are available for children who remain in the worship service. The clipboards have a kid's bulletin along with some crayons. You can pick one up by the kid's church checkin.
